Yukon Quest a Candidate for Induction into the Alaska Sports Hall of Fame

September 23, 2010 (Fairbanks, Alaska) – The Yukon Quest is among the candidates for induction for the Class of 2011 of the Alaska Sports Hall of Fame.

The Yukon Quest is being considered because of the positive impact it has had on the State of Alaska and its people. It is on the ballot for 2011 because it was one of the top vote getters from the previous vote in 2010.

The selection committee will announce the Class of 2011 on October 11th.
