



Requirements and Application for Official Qualifiers of the Yukon Quest

Minimum Qualifying Standards:

- Must be eligible distance (200 miles or more, OR 300 miles or more)
- Must be a continuous run race (stage races do not qualify)
- Must have a written set of rules
- Must have a Race Marshal overseeing the rules and the conduct of the race
- Must have a Vet Program to ensure good canine care
- Must support independent travel (no outside assistance allowed)
- It is suggested that all races honor Yukon Quest censures

Documents to be Submitted:

- Contact information for application (name, title, phone, fax, email)
- What qualifier being applied for (200 mile, 300 mile or both)
- Race website address, if applicable
- Current copy of rules
- Map or list of checkpoints with distances between each checkpoint
- Details of the Vet Program

Process:

All applications will be sent to the Yukon Quest Rules Committee

Timeline:

Applications and renewals received by the 3rd Friday of October to be approved by the 2nd Wednesday of November
The Official Qualifiers List approved in November will be posted on our website

Final Deadline:

Applications received after the 3rd Friday of October will not be considered for the upcoming year's Yukon Quest race.

Renewals:

Once a race has been approved as an Official Qualifier, renewal is required each year. The renewal request can be a short statement including any changes to contact information, website, rules, maps/checkpoint info and Vet Program. Documents are not required to be resubmitted each year, unless changes have been changes made.
